Interior Layout:

As you come down the companionway, Chieftain has a large "L" shaped galley to starboard and a comfortable Nav station to port. Aft of the companionway are port and starboard upper/lower bunks with storage lockers to port behind the nav station. Forward of the galley/nav station is the main saloon port and starboard settees with upper and lower bunks. The canting keel ram and wet-box are under the starboard "L" shaped settee. The mast is at the forward end of the main saloon. Forward of the main bulkhead is the head to starboard with the canard housing centered and not intrusive of the interior. To port are more storage lockers. In the forepeak is a large fixed "V" berth with plenty of storage underneath.
